ABOUT US

The Windermere Sports Club, established in 1976 in Werribee's Windermere suburb (renamed Wyndham Vale in 1977), began as a junior football club in the Western Suburban Football League (WSFL). The U/10 team won the club's first premiership in its inaugural year. In 1985, the club introduced its first Senior team in the WSFL Reserve Division, reaching the finals that same year.

Wyndhamvale Football Club achieved significant success from 2011 to 2013, with both Seniors and Reserves frequently reaching the Division 2 finals series. The Reserves won the Premiership in 2014, then again in 2022 following years of consecutive finals series.

The Seniors appeared in back-to-back Preliminary Finals in 2011 and 2012 and won the Division 2 Grand Final in 2015.

The club has been a pioneer in female football, with the U/18 Girls team winning the inaugural Youth Girl competition in Victoria in 2005. They achieved back-to-back premierships in 2006 and were runners-up in 2007. The Senior Women's team won the VWFL Division 3 premiership in 2014. In 2021, the club joined the WRFL Women's competition, securing a Minor Premiership and Grand Final appearance in 2023.

In 2023, the club introduced a Men's Thirds team in the RDFNL Club 18's competition, transitioning to the WRFL Thirds Competition in 2024.

The netball program, launched in 2021, fielded three teams across different divisions in 2024, reflecting the club's ongoing expansion and success.

The Junior Program at Wyndhamvale is thriving. We fielded 5 junior teams with the addition of a new U14 Girls team. We look to expand moving into 2025 with the addition of 2 U16 sides (boys and girls).

With over 400 participating players within our club and hundreds more spectators and volunteers, our club is only growing and we can't wait to see where future partnerships take us.
